 3. **Circuit Design:** Circuit schematic, component descriptions, and applied method
 4. **Simulation Results:** Proteus screenshots and observations
 5. **Conclusion and Evaluation:** Findings from the project, encountered issues (if any)
 6. **References** (if applicable)

Formatting and Writing Guidelines:

- **Font:** Times New Roman
- **Font Size:** 12 pt
- **Line Spacing:** 1.5
- **Page Margins:** Standard (2.5 cm on all sides)
- Each section heading must be **bold** and **numbered**.
- Each section should be written **briefly but clearly**, to improve readability.
