Preference and Promotion Days Were Held Between July 16 and August 2, 2024

Dr. Güven Özdemir Has Given A Statement to TV 100 About The Occupancy Rates Of Dams

Water in Dams Is Decreasing Day By Day! Be Careful: "Evaporation Is At Its Peak."

Experts frequently issue warnings due to high temperatures in Istanbul and throughout the country. Dr. **Güven Özdemir**, a meteorology engineer, drew attention to the fact that the temperatures were within seasonal norms and claimed that the current weather conditions are at a disaster level and are affecting dams as well.

Currently, the high temperatures have caused the occupancy rate of dams in Istanbul to rise to 61.03 percent. Meteorological engineer Dr. **Güven Özdemir** stated that we are enduring extremely hot weather conditions like a tragedy this summer. As a result of the elevated temperature and humidity, our daily water usage of 3.5 million tons is nearing 4 million tons. It is advantageous to utilize water with utmost care. "Due to the high temperatures, evaporation is currently at its maximum, resulting in a decrease in the water levels of dams. He claimed that the main causes of this were an increase in water consumption and evaporation from the water's surface.

While high temperatures have been effective in Istanbul and throughout the country

recently, experts warn against extreme heat and high humidity. It is being emphasized that one should avoid going out between 10:00 in the morning and 5:00 p.m. as much as possible. Meteorology Engineer, Dr. Lecturer **Güven Özdemir** spoke about evaporation and the latest situation in dams. On the other hand, the overall occupancy rate in Istanbul's dams was measured at 61.03 percent. The occupancy rate in Ömerli Dam was measured as 67.42 percent, Darlık Dam as 62.41 percent, Elmalı Dam as 63.6 percent, Terkos Dam as 74.07 percent, Alibey Dam as 29.98 percent, Büyükçekmece Dam as 57.67 percent, Sazlıdere Dam as 54.4 percent, Kazandere Dam as 33.51 percent, Istrancalar Dam as 38.52 percent, and Pabuçdere Dam as 43.48 percent.

The heat in Istanbul is extremely intense and feels like burning.

Meteorology Engineer Dr. **Güven Özdemir** stated that we are currently facing extremely high temperatures, which can be described as catastrophically hot weather this summer. In June of the previous year, the weather surpassed all previous temperature records. The trend

continued into July, and to exacerbate the situation, humidity levels began to rise. This phenomenon occurs due to the elevated temperature of the oceans and the swift movement of northerly winds, which efficiently transport the moisture from the Black Sea to the urban area. As the wind navigates through the city's towering structures, it gradually dissipates its velo-



city, resulting in the deposition of water vapor. Undoubtedly, the circumstances in the city are extremely challenging due to the presence of over 5 million automobiles, and air conditioners, and the prevalence of asphalt and concrete surfaces. These factors contribute to the rapid

release of heat into the atmosphere, leading to the production of heat islands as a consequence of urbanization and the utilization of fossil fuels in urban areas. Furthermore, these heat islands also contribute to the increase in atmospheric temperatures. As a result of the combination of high humidity and hot temperatures, we began to have tropical nights. Unfortunately, severe and distressing heat has been plaguing Turkey and major urban centers such as Istanbul, and we anticipate this pattern to persist throughout the summer.

The daily use of water has exceeded 4 million metric tons.

Turkey's summer is currently experiencing extremely high temperatures, surpassing previous records. This trend persists throughout July, with increased humidity levels due to elevated sea temperatures and northerly winds from the Black Sea. Tall buildings slow down the wind, causing water vapor to condense and remain in the atmosphere. Factors such as over 5 million cars, air conditioners, and extensive use of asphalt and concrete surfaces contribute to rapid heat release into the atmosphere, leading to the production of heat islands due to urbanization and fossil fuel usage. This has resulted in tropical nights and severe heat, with daily water consumption reaching over 4 million metric tons. We expect the pattern to persist throughout the summer, with major urban centers like Istanbul experiencing distressing heat. Meteorology Engineer Dr. Güven Özdemir stated.

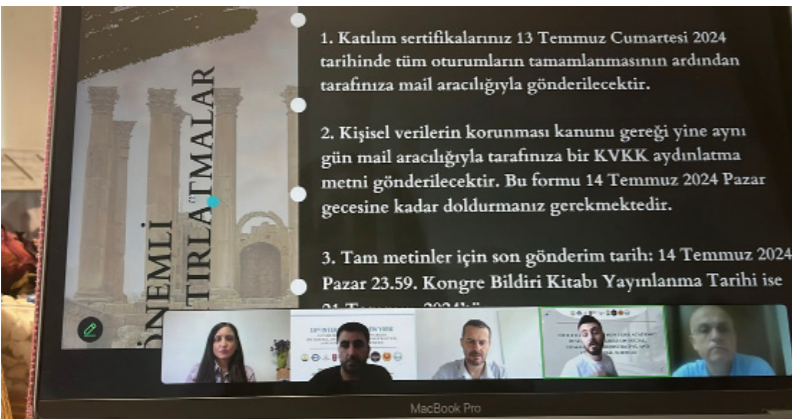
