Dr. Güven Özdemir Provides Insights to Hurriyet.com.tr Weather Conditions Expected in Istanbul in December

What weather patterns can be expected in December? Is snowfall anticipated in Istanbul?

Dr. Özdemir stated, "Cold weather conditions are expected to continue until Saturday, followed by..."

After a period of dry weather, heavy rain and snow have dominated across Turkey, leading to school closures in some cities and districts due to adverse weather conditions. Experts predict that cold and rainy weather will persist until Saturday. Will the cold weather and snow continue throughout December? Will there be snowfall in Istanbul? Meteorologist Dr. Güven Özdemir, a Instructor at Istanbul Aydın University, provided insights to hurriyet.com.tr.

Cold and rainy weather continues to affect Turkey. From the weekend onwards, temperatures have dropped by 10 to 15 degrees, and snow has been prevalent in some regions. The General Directorate of Meteorology reported that current weather conditions will persist this week, issuing yellow and orange alerts in some cities.

According to the latest forecasts, the northern, interior, and eastern regions of the country will be partly and heavily cloudy. Strong rain and showers are expected in the coastal areas of the Central Black Sea, as well as in Sinop and Giresun. The interior parts of the Eastern Black Sea region, along with Erzurum, Muş, Bitlis, Hakkari, and Şırnak, are forecasted to experience heavy and sometimes intense snowfall.

Will the cold weather and snowfall continue throughout December?

Will there be snowfall, especially in Istanbul?

We examined it closely with Dr. Güven Özdemir, a meteorology expert and faculty member at Istanbul Aydın University.

The Azores high-pressure system has brought positive results for Turkey.

Dr. Güven Özdemir, first addressing the reasons for the sudden cold weather, stated, "In the first week of November, under the influence of the Azores high-pressure system and African-origin air currents, we experienced a rather short period of drought, with temperatures below seasonal norms. However, in the last 15 days of November, the Azores high-pressure system moved into the northern parts of Central Europe and became persistent, which brought positive results for Turkey." Özdemir continued:

This situation caused polar cold air and rainy weather to flow into our country through the Balkans and the North Aegean. In recent days, consecutive low-pressure systems have increased their impact, first with strong southerly winds, followed by cold front rain, and the shift of winds





to the northwest, leading to powerful storms that dropped temperatures by 10-15 degrees. Additionally, heavy rain and sleet occurred at sea level, while the higher elevations experienced brief snowfall.”

The cold weather will continue uninterrupted until Saturday.

Dr. Güven Özdemir, emphasizing that this cold and rainy system will continue to move eastward, stated, “Starting today, fog and mist will be observed in most parts of our country, especially during the night and early morning hours. The risk of road icing will also increase. It is important for citizens to be cautious and follow traffic rules. I can confirm that the cold weather will continue without interruption until Saturday. Those involved in agriculture should take emergency measures against frost events in advance.”

How will the weather be in December?

Addressing the overall weather for December, Dr. Güven Özdemir stated, “Since November, the slowing down of the polar vortex and the disruption of jet streams have caused cold air from the polar regions to move southward. This situation, along with cold air flowing into our country from the northwest and north, will

increase the tendency for intermittent rainfall in December, influenced by the sea. We are expecting a colder and wetter December compared to last year.”

Additionally, reminding that “La Niña,” which is part of the natural climate cycle, can lead to extreme weather events, Özdemir stated, “La Niña, which has very strong oscillations, occurs when sea surface temperatures in the Central and Eastern Pacific Ocean drop below average. As it begins to affect the region, it can indirectly strengthen low-pressure systems that will reach our country.”

How will the weather be in Istanbul? Will there be snowfall?

Last weekend, due to a cold air wave, snowfall intensified in the higher elevations of Istanbul, while mixed rain and snow were observed in the city center. Will this situation become more intense in December?

Dr. Güven Özdemir, who stated that at least two or three significant snowfalls are expected across the country this year, said, “We may experience extreme weather events from time to time. As usual, strong snowfalls are expected in the higher elevations of Eastern Anatolia, Southeastern Anatolia, Central Anatolia, and the Black Sea regions. Additionally, we cannot ignore the possibility of light snowfall in Thrace and the Marmara region. Naturally, we are expecting snow in Istanbul as well, but for now, this situation does not seem very intense.”
