Asst. Prof. Dr. Güven Özdemir Participated In A Conversation On TRT News About The Expected Weather Conditions For Autumn

Will the fall weather be dry or rainy?

We anticipate that fall air temperatures will stay above average. The months of September and October should be hot and dry. We expect the anticipated rainfall in November to be particularly effective in coastal areas.

This year, Turkey has experienced an unprecedented hot summer; heat waves and drought have still left their impact. Despite it being the end of August, the expected coolness and desired amount of rain are not present. Especially the water levels in Istanbul's dams, one of the world's most populous cities, are decreasing day by day.

The months of September and October will have high temperatures

Dr. Özdemir, who started his conversation by stating that air temperatures will generally be above normal in autumn, said, "Air temperatures tend to be above normal in September, October, and November. Different regions of Turkey will continue to experience drought in September and October. Rainfall will be less than average in April, June, July, and August. It is unlikely that our country will experience effective rainfall in September and October. He stated, "we may see local rainfall, and in addition, there will be less rainfall than normal."

Promising forecast for precipitation in November

Expressing that the expected autumn rains can be seen in November, Dr. Özdemir continues his words as follows:

"The Black Sea, Marmara, Aegean, and Mediterranean are warm... In the Northern Aegean, seawater temperatures are currently around 24-27 degrees. Seawater temperatures rise to 24 degrees towards Babakale and Edremit Gulf, and 30-35 degrees as they go down. With warm seas and cooling weather in the fall, effective low-pressure systems will form





in these regions.”

Dr. Ozdemir also issues a warning for November:

“We think that the cyclones, namely low-pressure systems, that will form mostly in the Central Mediterranean in November will be effective together with floods, tornadoes,

and storms when they come over the sea. Meteorological model studies show this.”

Which areas, subsequently, will have higher fall precipitation amounts?

In response to this query, Dr. Özdemir states: “considerable precipitation is expected in our coastal regions, specifically on the Black Sea coast, the Aegean and Mediterranean coasts, and the area east of Marmara. Naturally, the rains will eventually expand and have their impacts on the inland areas.”



Is Istanbul susceptible to drought?

We may state that Istanbul, home to millions of people, had dry summers and even springs. Currently, less than 50% of dams are in use. Dr. Özdemir uses the following remarks to call attention to Istanbul’s water crisis:

“In Istanbul, there is a heat island formation. The large population of the metropolis, the density of vehicles, the location of industry within the city, and the use of fossil fuels all contribute to the intense emission of greenhouse gases into the atmosphere. It traps the sun’s radiation on and around the city. It creates a greenhouse effect. The rainfall that will come to the metropolis is largely blocked, and it can occur outside of Istanbul. When we look at the dams, there is a 48 percent occupancy rate. We are in a good situation compared to last year, but it is rapidly decreasing.

There is a 19-20 percent difference between last month and this month. In the autumn months, the water in our dams will be enough for Istanbul, but the population is too high.

This should not make us complacent. September and October appear to be dry months. Therefore, water conservation is important.”

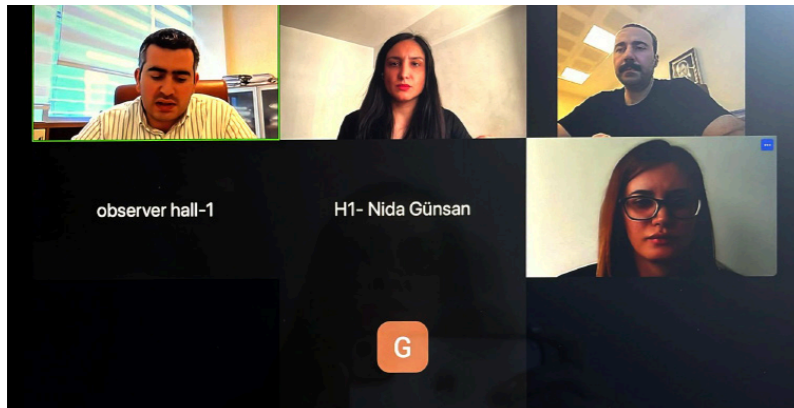


Instructor Korkmaz Keskendir's Book Is Published
