Dr. Güven Özdemir, He Commented To Hürriyet Haber Concerning The Weather Conditions Anticipated From La Niña This Year

El Nino is over, and La Nina is starting! When will the weather cool down? Will there be rain in October? 'This autumn will be different from previous years'

Following the conclusion of the El Nino period, September brought about the La Nina weather event. This has caused changes to the precipitation regime in many regions, including our country. We spoke with Meteorology Specialist Dr. Güven Özdemir about the weather conditions that La Nina will bring this year, whether temperatures will drop in the coming days, and whether autumn will be fully felt in October.

Climate change and other factors have radically disrupted our meteorological habits.

As we learned in primary school, summers in many parts of Turkey are hot and dry, while winters are mild and rainy. However, weather events in recent years have virtually destroyed these patterns. For the last couple of years, we have been entering winter without fully experiencing autumn, and stepping out of winter into the hot days of summer.

Although we have reached the end of September this year, the expected rainfall has not occurred. Especially with the La Nina period spreading around the world, the expected drop in temperatures has not occurred. This situation has once again revealed the complex and unpredictable nature of the climate process.

The destructive power of tropical cyclones is enhanced by shifts in air pressure zones.

El Nino, which is found in the Pacific Ocean, raises global temperatures beginning in oceanic regions, whereas La Nina, its opposite, denotes colder weather.

Events known as El Nino and La Nina typically span nine to twelve months, though they can extend beyond that. El Nino began in June of last year and concluded in April of this year. It happens every two to seven years.

Dr. Güven Özdemir, a meteorology specialist at Istanbul Aydın University, explained to me why temperatures have not decreased this year despite the shift to La Nina: "Increasing greenhouse gas emissions as a result of human activities increase the effect of air heat waves, and the spread of these waves covers large areas." and added:

"Sea surface temperatures have risen significantly above the global norm over the past 40 years, as evidenced by changes in the natural ecosystem." Furthermore, shifts in air pressure zones make tropical cyclones more destructive and raise the possibility of excessive heat, dryness, and unexpected rains. Even though the





rise in greenhouse gas emissions predates the industrial revolution, it is currently having an irreversible detrimental impact on the ecosystem, life, and environment.

La Nina will not have a direct impact on our country, but...

“La Nina manifests itself through the strengthening of trade winds in the Pacific Ocean,” said Dr. Güven Özdemir. “There is still no strong La Nina effect in that region.” La Nina cannot have a direct effect on our country. However, we can observe what we refer to as the butterfly effect, which is an indirect effect.

weather and stated that throughout the summer, African attacks and Azores high pressure were successful. That being said, fall has officially arrived. Both the length of the day and the amount of sunshine are decreasing. “This autumn will be distinct from previous years,” she said, emphasizing the following details: September is not following its typical pattern of precipitation; local and regional high rainfall, as well as thunderstorm activity, is becoming more frequent. Low pressure over the Balkans will influence the upcoming days, bringing cold weather to Istanbul and its neighboring areas. There will be sporadic downpours and a decrease in temperature in Thrace, Marmara, the northern regions of Central and Eastern Anatolia, the Black Sea, the inner Aegean, and the northern section of Thrace.



What will the weather be like in October?

“We should forget about the abundant and continuous rainfall of the fall season,” said Dr. Güven Özdemir. “Instead, intermittent regional rainfall is taking its place. The fall season has begun, yet it differs significantly from the previous one. It appears that the fall season will no longer be as it was. October does not seem to be much different from September. We can predict that the temperature will fluctuate between seasonal norms and occasionally exceed them. Our country’s seawater temperatures are also similar to the global average. How does this impact the weather conditions?”

Dr. Güven Özdemir responded to my question by saying, “Human activities cause the repulsive effects in the atmosphere to increase and spread rapidly, causing the oceans and seas to warm and acidify.” This warming causes changes in temperature, wind, precipitation, and air current pressure.

“Changes in the ecosystem cause a decrease in fish yields, a shift in the ecosystem to the north, and the settlement of creatures from tropical climates,” Dr. Güven Özdemir went on. Drought and deforestation also signal the start of an irreversible trend. As a result, the meteorological drought persists, and the signs of the hydraulic drought are also evident. Regretfully, sinkholes are developing, subsurface water is disappearing, and water levels in lakes, ponds, dams, and rivers are rising.

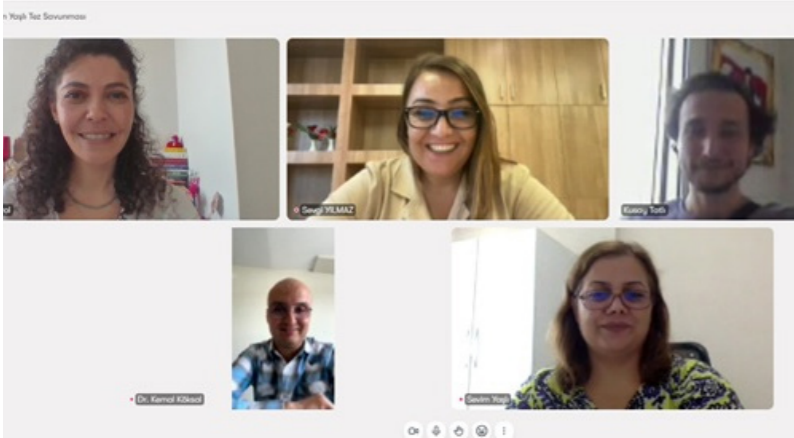


At ICEBS 2024, Ayten Nahide Korkmaz Presented Her Paper

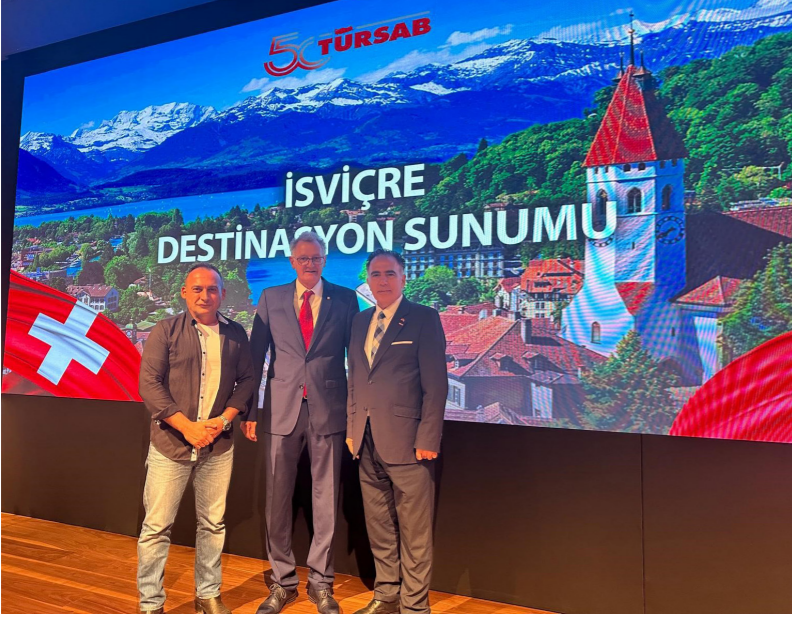
