## Dr. Güven Özdemir provided a statement to Anadolu Agency concerning the precipitation rates in the Marmara Region

Rainfall in the Marmara region increased by 28% last year compared to the long-term average for 1991-2020 and by 38% in December compared to the previous year.

According to the data compiled by the Anadolu Agency correspondent from the General Directorate of Meteorology, the average rainfall in the region for December was measured at 90.3 millimeters. In December 2023, 83.7 millimeters of rain fell in the region, while in the same period of the previous year, an average of 115.4 millimeters of rain was recorded. Thus, it was determined that the December rainfall in the region increased by 28% compared to the long-term average and by 38% compared to the same period of the previous year. It was also found that rainfall increased by more than 40% in the northern part of Thrace. The number of rainy days varied from 20 to 25 in areas such as Istanbul, Kocaeli, Sakarya, Yalova, Çanakkale, and Balıkesir.

### “Other regions do not experience as much precipitation as the Marmara Region.”

Dr. Güven Özdemir, a faculty member at Istanbul Aydın University and a meteorology expert, stated in an interview with the AA correspondent that precipitation in Turkey decreased by 4% compared to the seasonal average in December but increased by 7% compared to the same period of the previous year. Özdemir noted that the Marmara Region experienced a rainy period in December, whereas in Oc-

tober and November, the region did not receive the expected rainfall.

Özdemir indicated that December precipitation in the Marmara Region rose by 28% relative to the seasonal norm and by 38% compared to the corresponding month last year. He stated, “In other regions, precipitation is less than in the Marmara Region.” Regrettably, drought persists in the Southeastern Anatolia Region.

Özdemir emphasized that the water reservoirs supplying Istanbul are about 50% full and remarked, “In December, low-pressure systems that bring rainy weather reached the Marmara Region. Consequently, we received some precipitation, but we are still facing a snow drought, which is a serious concern. Similar to January, we anticipate a shortage of precipitation in the first half of February.”

Özdemir emphasized the importance of using water efficiently, stating that even if reservoirs are full, it is still not sufficient. He stressed the need for water conservation, saying, “Industries, schools, and institutions must also be mindful of water usage. We should collect rainwater and recycle the water we use. This water needs to be treated and reused, for instance, in garden irrigation and other purposes.”
