
CONFERENCE

Inter-class debating events were organized at the English Preparatory School in April.





THE POLICIES OF THE FINLAND TOWARDS THE ARCTIC REGION

The Arctic region holds great significance for Finland throughout its history. Finland is an active Polar actor. Finland is a part of the Arctic Council's eight permanent members and among the 29 consultative parties involved in decision-making regarding Antarctica as stated by the Ministry for the Foreign Affairs of Finland. Finlands' Arctic strategy is a comprehensive effort to establish its strategie goals and policies in the Arctic region. The strategy aims to ensure active participation of Finland in the Arctic geography, seize potential opportunities in the region and promote sustainable development. Additionally, it also encompasses promoting sustainable development Additionally, it also encompasses promoting sustainable utilization of natural resources in the Arctic region and strengthening environmental protection measures. Finland seeks to boost the stability and prosperity of the Arctic region by enhancing international collaboration in the area.

Finland is widely seen as a major player in the Arctic region. The Rovaniemi Declaration,'s signed in 1991 by the United States of America, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Denmark, Canada, Norway, Sweden, Iceland, and other countries, acknowledged Finland as an Arctic nation for the first time and led to the implementation of the Arctic Environmental Protection Strategy. Subsequently, Finland became an Arctic state by joining the Arctic Council, created through the Ottawa Declaration's of 1996. With its strategic geopolitical location positioned between Russia and other European countries, Finland's vital role in the Arctic region, especially concerning neighbouring countries, including areas like culture, environment, economy.
