- Objective: increasing participation and providing better access to quality further and higher education opportunities in the neighbouring region for vulnerable Syrian youth and host communities
- Funding provided by the EU Regional Trust Fund in Response to the Syrian Crisis ("Madad Fund")
- Duration: 2016 2019
- Budget: 12 Mio. EUR
- Countries: Turkey, Jordan, Lebanon, Iraq (KRI), Egypt

#### **Education Counselling and Scholarship Fund**

- Cooperation with UNHCR (DAFI Programme)
- 417 scholarships awarded in two intakes
- Bachelor and Master studies
- Syrian and local students
- Planned intake for courses below BA level
- > 5000 students received counselling







#### Distribution of scholarships

Country	Total number	Syrians	Locals
Jordan	59	45	14
Lebanon	145	87	58
KRI	96	86	10
Egypt	28	28	0
Turkey	114	114	0



#### **Higher Education English Access Programme (HEEAP)**

- 13 agreements concluded with universities in Turkey, Jordan, Lebanon and Egypt
- Currently > 500 students enrolled
- 112 English teachers trained
- Syrians and locals



#### **Call for Proposals**

- Funding up to 60.000 EUR
- 20 projects selected in first call
- Topics (extract):
  - Support to HE application
  - Recognition of previous qualifications
  - Digital education
- Second call expected before 2018
