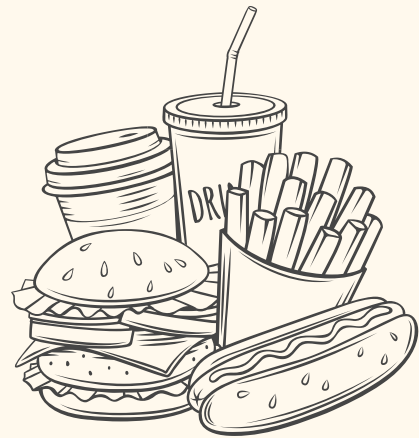
Campus Map



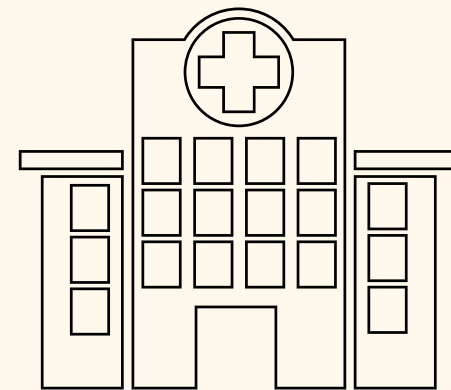

ISTANBUL AYDIN UNIVERSITY / TÖMER has been designed in accordance with the European Common Language Criteria. It offers a modern learning environment to all international students living in Turkey and coming from abroad.

Incoming students at IAU can take the free-of-charge **TLL104 Introduction to Turkish Language and Culture** course for **5 ECTS** during the Spring term. Make sure to **add it to the LA** to get the credits!

After Arrival

If you do not have Turkish citizenship, you are required to apply for a **Turkish Residence Permit** after entering Turkey.

If you are late with the application, certain fines are applied.

The application for the residence permit must be made within **30 days** after entering the country.

To apply for a residence permit, you should come to the **Erasmus+ Office** or the **International Academic Relations Office**. (J Block, 2nd Floor)



Required Documents for Residence Permit

- 5 **biometrical** pictures (Size 5 x 6)
- Scan of the **1st page** of your passport, **last stamp of entrance** in the country and visa (if it is required)
- **Official Rental Contract** endorsed by Turkish Public Notary
- **Receipt of payment** for residence permit card fee
- **Student letter** (from Student Affairs Office in T Block)
- **Insurance** for residence permit purpose ONLY
- **Tax Number**
- **Governmental Tax Payment**





Tax Number



In order to pay for your residence permit, you should obtain tax number so you can pay at the closest tax office. You will need an Turkish address and Turkish phone number. **Mentors will help you obtain it during the Orientation Week.**

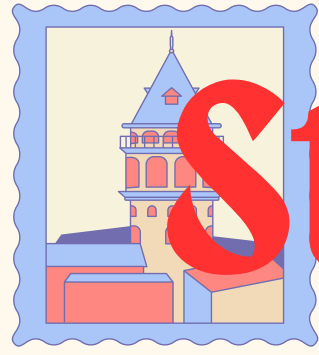

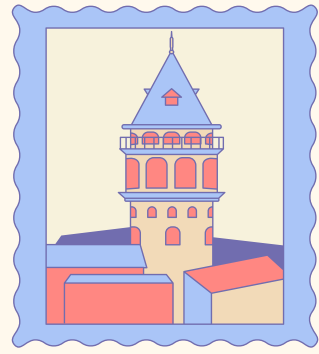

With **RED** (General Use) Istanbul card, you can travel anywhere you want in Istanbul. You can obtain the card from the vending machines located in all public transport stations in Istanbul. The fee for the card is 130 TL.

You will be given these 2 upon your arrival to IAU.

In Istanbul, students are entitled to use all public transport (buses, trams, metro, ferries) at a reduced price with the **GREEN** (Discounted Student) Istanbul Card. During the orientation week Mentors will help you obtaining them.



Banking

If you have a **mastercard** or **visa**, you can use it freely in Türkiye.

Revolut card has less commissions and it is more comfortable to be used here.

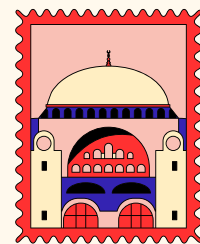
You can withdraw money from your **HalkBank** ATMs with minimum commissions.

As a foreigner, you can open a bank account in Türkiye only with your Turkish residence permit at **Ziraat Bankası**, **EnPara** and **Papara**.

Türkiye's currency is the **Turkish lira (TRY)**.

For converter. ➡

If you are coming with euros or dollars and you want to exchange them to Turkish Liras, you should do it in a **Döviz Bürosu**, not in the Airport because Airport commissions are higher.

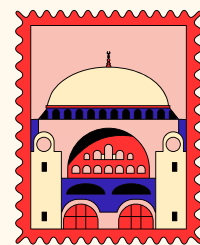
📍 If you want to rent a room/ flat you should consider the **European side** close to university.

Insurance

Get the original signed and stamped forms from your national medical insurance company.

GERMANY: T/A 11 form

NETHERLANDS: N/TUR 111 form

BELGIUM: B.T.8 form

AUSTRIA: A/TR 3 form

You will need 2 insurances: 1 for a residence permit **ONLY**, and the other one you obtain from **your country**, which can be used for medical purposes as long as it covers you during your stay in Türkiye.

NOTE: the health insurance policies made in your home country, apart from the forms mentioned above, will not be accepted by the Foreigner's Police when applying for a Residence Permit BUT you can still use them to get treatment in Türkiye.

Additional Info ✈️ From The Airport

In İstanbul, there are two airports. One is **Istanbul Airport** (Europe Side) and **Sabiha Gökçen Airport** (Asia Side).

From Istanbul Airport

- You can use HAVAIST busses from -2 Floor
- There are 5 İETT busses (public transportation)
- You can use the M11 metro line
- Or you can take a taxi /Uber

From Sabiha Gökçen Airport

- You can use HAVAIST busses
- There are 10 İETT busses (Public Transportation)
- You can take the M4 metro line
- You can take a taxi/Uber

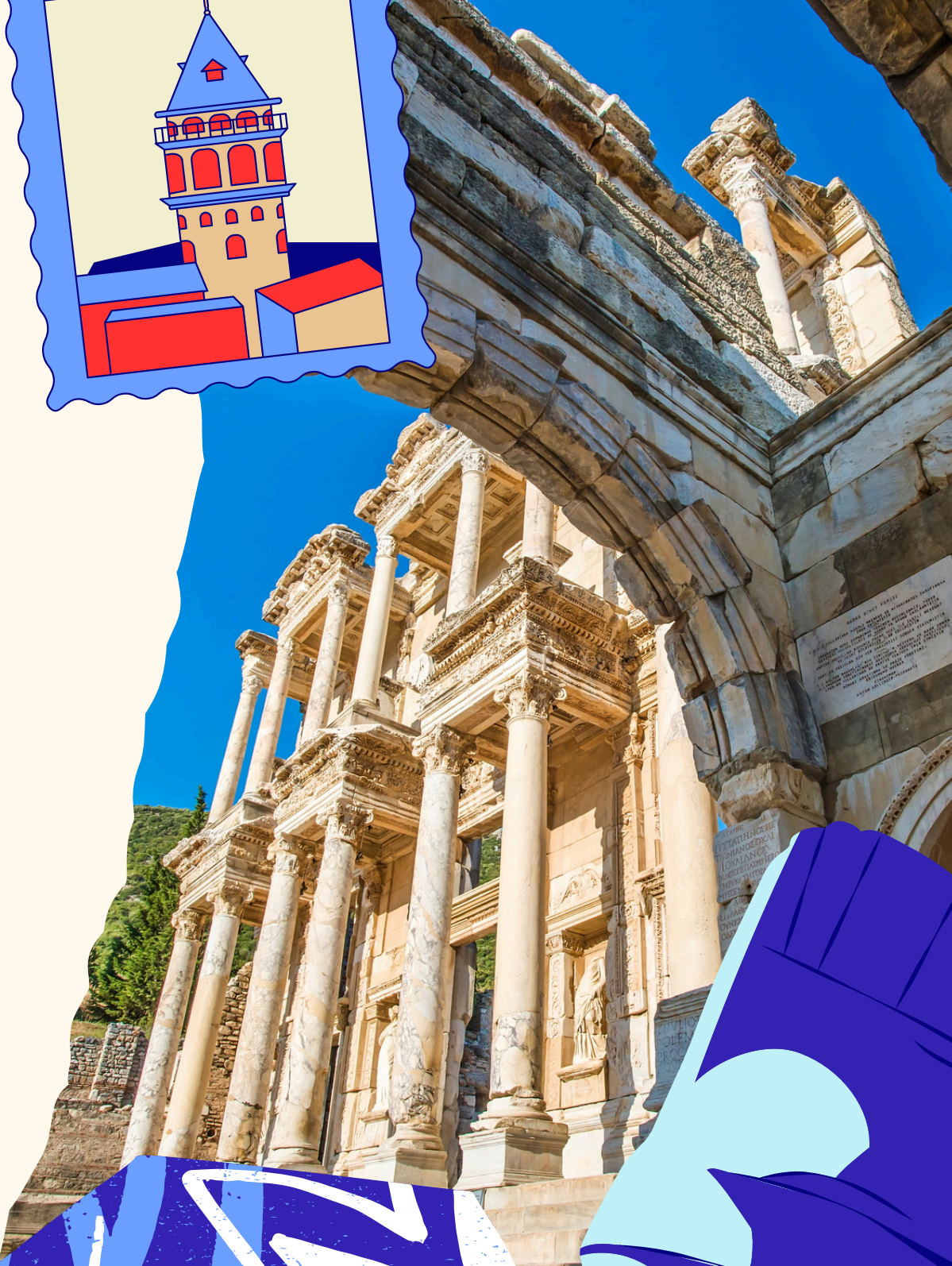


Additional Info ❄️ Weather

Türkiye experiences all four seasons distinctly, with warm, **sunny summers**, **mild and rainy springs and autumns**, and cold, **snowy winters** in many regions.

Before coming to Istanbul in fall and winter, it's best to bring a variety of layers. In fall, a light jacket or sweater and a waterproof coat are essential. For winter, a warm coat is essential. Also, include waterproof shoes for the wet weather and comfortable walking shoes for exploring the city.

In spring, Istanbul's mild weather can be rainy, so pack a light jacket, T-shirts, and long-sleeve shirts for layering. Bring jeans or trousers, a waterproof jacket, and a small umbrella for unexpected showers. Comfortable, waterproof footwear and accessories like sunglasses and a hat for sunny days are also recommended.



Cuisine Day

Every year in **May** we host **the International Cuisine Day**, which involves the presentation of your culture by preparing some **traditional dishes**, preparing some **interactive presentations**, **dances** or **music** specific to your country.

If you are interested in participating in this event, we recommend bringing with you the national costume, and certain foods that do not require special storage conditions.

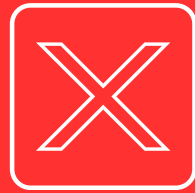
