Eurasia Leadership Trek 2018

The Eurasia Leadership Trek (ELT), organized by scholars from the Harvard University, and under the auspices of the Center for Asia Leadership Initiatives, is a socioeconomic and political study tour and public service program that covers five countries. ELT is to be held from May 25 to June 14, 2018 on the theme of "Understanding Geopolitical Dimensions and Regional Outlook."

The ELT 2018 will explore Tbilisi, Georgia; Baku, Azerbaijan; Ankara and Istanbul, Turkey; Chisinau, Moldova, and Kyiv, Ukraine. Our program aims to provide first-hand insight through an experiential journey, in which our participants directly investigate political, economic, industry, or societal issues through engagement with relevant leaders and organizations on the field. Importantly, our accomplished participants are keen to learn more and discuss the themes of democratic reforms, regional security, EU and NATO integration as well as economic development of the wider Black Sea region countries.

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RESIDENCE PERMIT APPOINTMENT SYSTEM HAS BEEN OPENED ON UBIS

Required Documents for the First Time Student Residence Permit Application;

1. Online Residence Permit Application Form (Form needs to printed out and signed on the 4thpage)

2. Passport and photocopy of passport (Pages containing identity information, photo and bearing stamps)

3. Four (4) biometric photos (must be taken within the last 6 months; the picture needs to have a white background)

4. Declaration which states that financial capacity is to be provided sufficiently and regularly throughout your stay in Turkey (as declared in the application form. Please note that the Directorate General of Migration Office in Istanbul may request supporting documents.)

(From ISSA Office – J Block Ground Floor)

5. Valid Health Insurance (Insurance period must cover the intended residence permit duration.) (Click here for further information)

6. Student Letter (This document is valid 15 days after issuing) (From F Block – 1)

7. Tax Payment Receipt (covering the fees related to the Residence Permit)

The nearest Tax Office to University is in Avcılar (Adres: Cihangir, Ormanlı Cd. Avcılar Hükümet Konağı No:55, 34310 Avcılar/İstanbul/ Metrobus : Avcılar Merkez Station)

8. Name Declaration (It is necessary, If your name and surname is written together and not clear in your passport)

9. If you are under 18 years old:

-Permission letter from your parents

-Birth certificate

(These two documents must be stamped by your Consulate.)

Don't Forget!

Step 1 – Make an Online Student Residence Permit Application from www.goc.gov.tr.

Step 2 - Once you completed the online application process, if you see a specific appointment date in your application form, you must go to Immigration Office with your required documents (As you can see above) and submit them. If there isn't an appointment date in your application form, please be aware that you must submit your documents to International Student & Staff Affairs (ISSA Office) within 30 days. How to submit my required documents to ISSA Office?




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SUCCESS STORY

Do you know about IAU Carrier Center?

Work placement lesson is between weeks 12 February- 18 May. Our students must enter the information of companies and work placement days until 17 February- 23:59. (Work Placement tab in your UBIS)

For work placement you must take an appointment with phone before you go (There is no obligation that the company approve you, first you need to call.)

First impression is very important, be careful appearance, promptitude, hygiene etc... You must represent yourself and the university in the best way.

Students which are guided by our Career Center, will complete their work placements in the companies they are sent. (there will be no change of company)

Residence Permit Appointment System

Due to new rules and regulation of Directorate General of Migration Management, Ministry of Interior of Republic of Turkey, students shall submit their residence permit document to the school. The new rules enhance for students not to visit immigration office anymore.



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Procedure for students to submit their application to the ISSA office:

Students must take an online appointment from the online system for submitting their required documents to International Students and staff Affairs(ISSA) office, after taking the appointment, they can visit ISSA office for further procedure.
