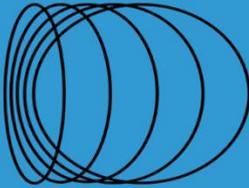

Global Climate Change, Environment and Energy II. We Organized the International Symposium

We held the 2nd “Global Climate Change, Environment and Energy International Symposium” on April 18, 2018. National and international academicians who are experts in their fields took part in the symposium both through the Organizing Committee, the Scientific Committee and through the notifications.

In the symposium, climate changes that threaten global stability and the issues of combating major disasters were examined with a multidimensional approach and the interdependence relationship between them was revealed. In addition, a platform was created to discuss the problems and solutions that have emerged and will emerge with the symposium.

The papers presented at the symposium and the final declarations of the workshops held before the symposium will be included in the symposium book to be published.

We organized the "Global Climate Change, Environment and Energy II International Symposium" under the coordination of Istanbul Aydın University Energy Policies and Markets Application and Research Center (EPPAM).

The full text of the paper in which we share the suggestions we have developed for the solution of the problem will be published in the Symposium Proceedings Booklet.






We made a press statement about the earthquake in Adıyaman Samsat

On April 24, 2018, at 03:34, a 5.1 magnitude earthquake was felt in the epicenter of the village of Kırmacı, Samsat District of Adıyaman Province, which caused anxiety in the region. According to the Ministry of Health data, 39 people were admitted to hospitals during the earthquake without serious injuries and 35 people were reported to be continuing their treatment. According to official figures, as a result of the earthquake, 5 structures received minor damage, 75 structures received moderate damage, 75 structures received severe damage, and 2 residences were completely destroyed. Director of Istanbul Aydın University Disaster Training Application and Research Center Mr. Prof. Dr. M. Fatih Altan informs the public about the earthquake through the press.
