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

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Proceedings of the workshop on drowning and pulling (Rip) currents were published


On June 20, 2018, the book containing the papers of the workshop we held with the support of Istanbul Aydın University Disaster Training Application and Research Center, Yıldız Technical University Natural Sciences Research Center and Bezmîâlem Vakıf University Disaster Management Department, with the support of the Istanbul Branch of the Chamber of Geological Engineers, was published.

There are 13 papers prepared by academics and experts from various universities, institutions, organizations and non-governmental organizations such as Yıldız Technical University, Istanbul Technical University, Bezmîâlem Vakıf University, General Directorate of Coastal Security, NTV, Forensic Medicine Institute and AKUT.

The workshop paper book, which was held in three separate sessions: flow hydrodynamics, drowning cases and Crime Scene Management and medical approach in drowning cases, is accessed via the following link.

In the manifesto, what is the current that attracts?, Effect of coastal structures on near coastal currents, effect of Istanbul Strait current structure on drowning events in summer, studies on currents that attract Istanbul between 2007 and 2016, examples of methods used in determining regions of attract currents, cases of drowning in water in 2017, Crime Scene Management in drowning cases, location of drowning cases in the media, acute and Black Sea drowning cases, stages of operation in response to the casualty, pathophysiology of drowning in water, Emergency approach to water drowning and pulling currents, forensic approach to water drowning are included in the papers prepared in the titles.





AFAM 2017-2018 Period Press Reflections Published

When the geography where Turkey is located is evaluated as a land without human life, it offers a unique laboratory environment where the risks that may turn into a disaster can be examined with its tectonic formation, geological structure, topography and meteorological characteristics. However, when the subject concerns human life, it becomes necessary to be prepared for disasters.

On the basis of disaster preparedness, the individual, family, all relevant public and private institutions should take responsibility and cooperate and complete pre-disaster mitigation and preparation studies in a comprehensive manner. Thus, there will be less need for intervention and recovery efforts after a possible disaster. It is of vital importance to extend this approach, which is accepted as Modern Disaster Management in the world, throughout our country, and universities have important duties in this regard.

With this awareness of responsibility, we take care to regularly share with the public our knowledge and experience, which we have gained in the light of science, with our Disaster Training, Application and Research Center, which has been working on capacity building against disasters since 2009.

As a result of this effort, we shared our experiences with the public with 509 news, under 20 different titles, through 183 different media outlets at the national and local level, and informed the public about the roles and responsibilities that should be taken for disasters during the 2017 - 2018 education period.
